## **GUNY Survey 2022**

#### KS1 Positives (Total: 44 children Girls: 25 Boys: 19)

- 95% of all children feel safe at home.
- 100% girls responded that they have had lessons about these things at school: friendships, families, keeping safe online, healthy eating, how to be kind to others and how to care for the planet and keep it safe.
- 100% of boys responded that they have had lessons about these things at school: how to be kind to others and how to care for the planet and keep it safe.
- All children responded to over 90% that they have had lessons about these things at school: how you feel (emotions), how to keep yourself healthy and how to be kind to people who are different to us.
- 93% of all children responded that if they have any worries or are upset they have an adult to go to.

## KS1 Areas for Development (Total: 44 children Girls: 25 Boys: 19)

- 11% boys always feel happy at school
- 36% girls always feel happy at school
- 50% girls said yes to enjoying physical activity and sports.
- 61% boys said yes to enjoying physical activity and sports.
- Boys said they worry about school work (50%), friendships (39%) and family (56%) most days.
- Girls said they worry about being ill (44%) and family (52%) most days.
- 16% girls are read a bedtime story at home.
- 25% boys are read a bedtime story at home.

### KS2 Positives (Total: 34 children Girls: 14 Boys: 18)

- 83% boys either agree or strongly agree to enjoying taking part in physical activities and sports.
- 94% boys either agree or strongly agree to understanding why physical activities and sports is good for me.
- 93% girls either agree or strongly agree to understanding why physical activities and sports is good for me.
- 86% girls either agree or strongly agree to knowing how to improve skills in different types of sports.
- 100% boys responded that they have felt happy 'always, often or sometimes' in the past two weeks.
- 86% girls responded that they have felt happy 'always, often or sometimes' in the past two weeks.
- 85% all children responded that it's OK to make mistakes.
- 82% children agree that the school teaches them to treat each other with respect.

# KS2 Areas for development (Total: 34 children Girls: 14 Boys:18)

- 93% girls felt tired at school yesterday.
- 61% boys felt tired at school yesterday.
- Children (total) said they worry about the following 'quite' or very often. SAT's (32%), the way they look (47%), your weight (41%), being bullied (35%), family (41%), falling out with friends (41%) feeling lonely (41%), war (38%), death of someone close to you (68%).
- Girls have responded that they have been bullied or 'picked' on at or near school for the following reasons in the past 12 months. Your size and weight (50%), the way you look (43%).
