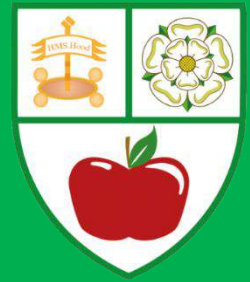

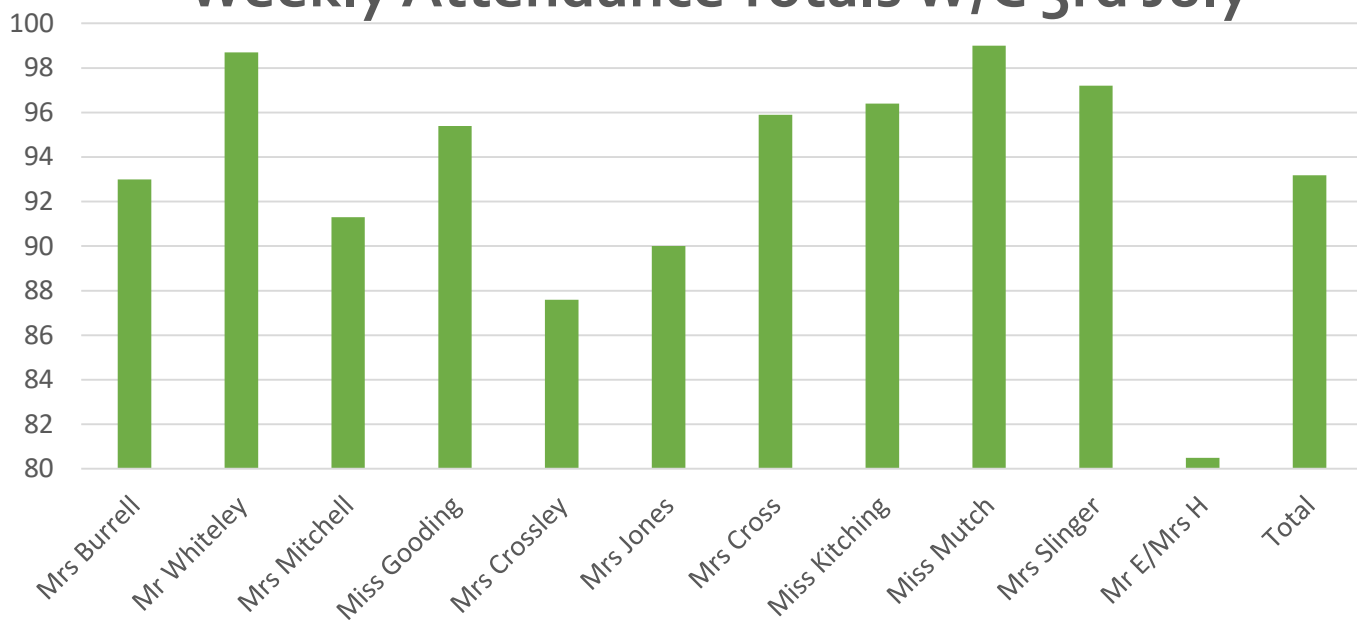

**Do messages about attendance apply to my child in Reception (and Nursery)?**

Whilst legal enforcement actions for attendance do not apply to children under 5, regular routines for young children support the settling-in process and enhance their sense of security. Even if a child only misses just one session, it can seriously impact on their learning and development and readiness for school.

When your child starts in our Nursery or Reception, there is an agreement that you will support your child and school to achieve excellent attendance in order to ensure they get off to the best possible start. The only reason a child should be absent is for illness or other family emergencies.

## Our Safeguarding Team

At school we have five members of staff and a governor who make up our Safeguarding Leadership Team. Mr Peoples is our Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL); he is the lead person responsible for child protection and safeguarding issues. Mrs Jo Burnside is our Safeguarding Link Governor. The role of the Safeguarding Governor is to support the DSL as well as regularly review, ask questions and make suggestions about our safeguarding policies and procedures and to report back to the governing body.

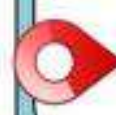
