Year 5 & Year 6	<p><b>Portraits</b></p> <p>Children learn about how French adjectives have to agree, how to describe people in French, describing personality traits and writing portraits of friends in French.</p>	<p><b>Meet my French Family</b></p> <p>Children learn family and relations vocabulary, the possessive adjective 'my' and how to express likes and dislikes.</p>	<p><b>Clothes and Getting Dressed</b></p> <p>Children learn to describe clothes in French and learn where the adjective goes. They learn the vocabulary to describe what they and others are wearing.</p>	<p><b>French weather</b></p> <p>Children learn some weather phrases and write a weather report, including compass points and temperature</p>	<p><b>Exploring the French-speaking World</b></p> <p>Children learn about French-speaking countries, learn to give and follow directions in French, discuss climate and use comparative language.</p>	<p><b>Planning a French Holiday</b></p> <p>Children use a combination of present and near-future tenses and become familiar with holiday-related vocabulary around packing a suitcase and planning a journey</p>

Year 5 & Year 6	<p><b>French transport</b></p> <p>Children will learn about transport in France and how to describe it using adjectives in the masculine or feminine</p>	<p><b>In my French house</b></p> <p>Children will know a range of prepositions to describe the position of objects in the home</p>	<p><b>Music in France</b></p> <p>Children will understand cultural references in different types of music from French-speaking countries, such as Zouk from Martinique and in the French song Sur le pont d'Avignon and to use et or mais to extend sentences</p>	<p><b>French verbs in a week</b></p> <p>Children will understand that French verbs take different forms. Regular verbs follow a pattern and some verbs are irregular.</p>	<p><b>Visiting a town in France</b></p> <p>Children will be able to recognise grammatical elements in a written text: nouns, verbs, adjectives, pronouns and prepositions when describing a town in France</p>	<p><b>French sport and the Olympics</b></p> <p>Children will know the names of some French sports and be able to write sentences about events at the Olympics</p>
