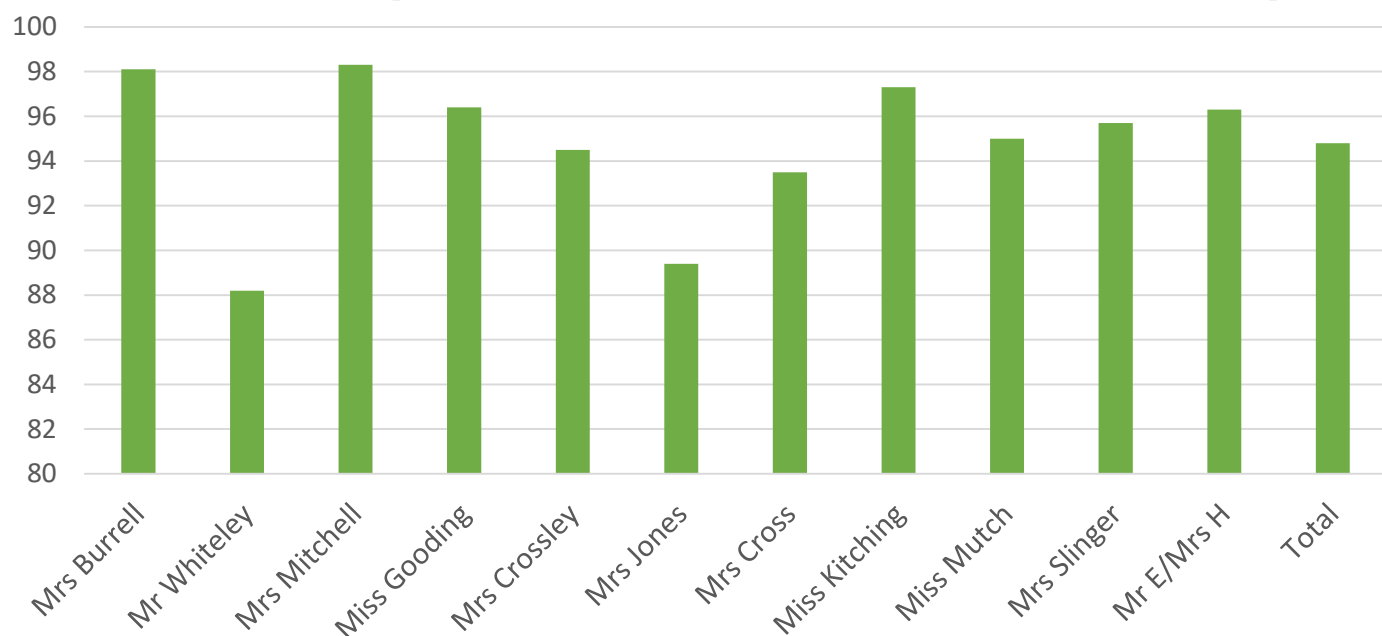

It may also lead to a Child Missing Education referral. This all takes up an enormous amount of valuable time, and it can be easily avoided if we have received a form.
