

However, it still important to complete a Leave of Absence Request (available from the office the website: or on https://www.applegarth.n-yorks.sch.uk/key-information/attendance/). It is vital that we know where pupils are if they are not in school. If we are not notified about a holiday, we will phone, text, email and visit the family home every day. It may also lead to a Child Missing Education referral. This all takes up an enormous amount of valuable time, and it can be easily avoided if we have received a form.

Pupils almost always tell us and their friends that they have been on holiday, so it is not a way to bypass the penalty notice.
