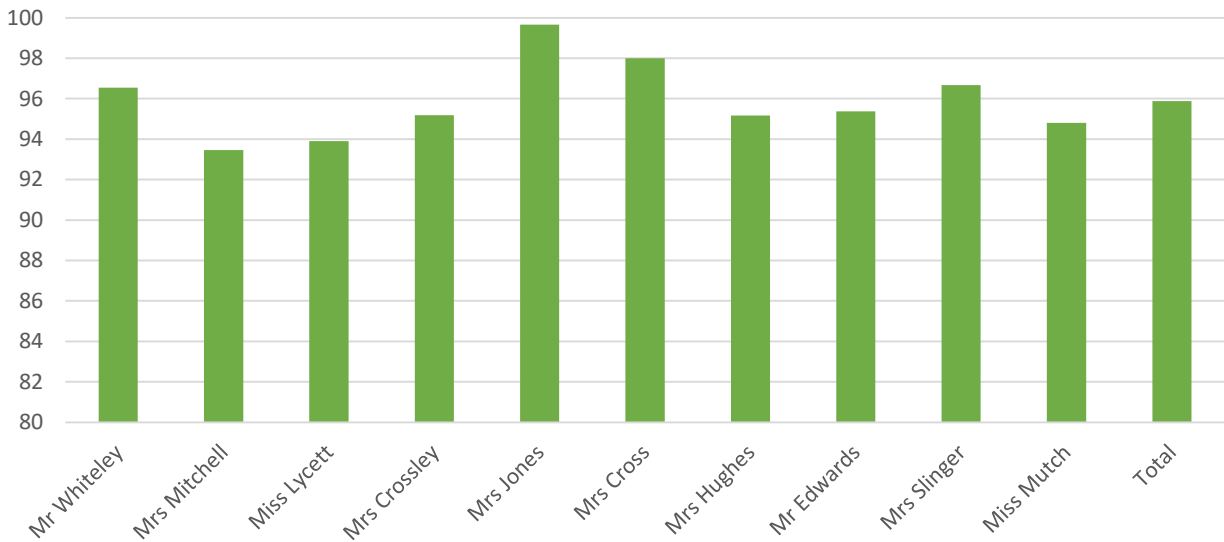

## CYCLE - Property Marking Event

We are inviting you to a property marking event which is going to be held at Northallerton Police Station, on Sunday 10th March 2024 at 13:30hrs until 15:00hrs

The aim of these events, are to assist you in being able to place a unique marking on some of your property, to allow you to register the items on a security database.

We currently work with Immobilise - <https://www.immobilise.com>  
By visiting their database, you will be able to create your own portfolio, uploading serial numbers and identification marks, which, if the worse happens, you will be able to mark items as stolen.

Our team will be able to talk you through the marking process on the day.

The method doesn't scratch, we use a precision hammer, which impacts in to the property, creating a permanent mark.



For this reason, any young people wanting items like bikes marking, will require a parent/guardian to attend with them.

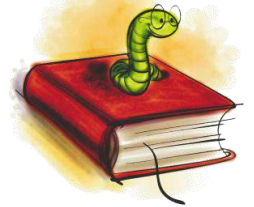


## Reminder About Access to School Car Park

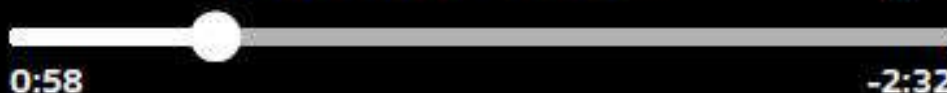

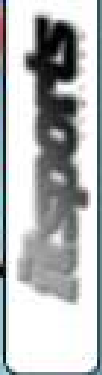
